

Withdrawing Consent

Parents/carers and children all have the right to have their data protected. The GDPR provides children with the same rights as adults. In our setting, we take this seriously and will hold, process and store data in accordance with the GDPR. There is data that I am legally obliged to keep in accordance with the GDR and the EYFS.

I have designed the forms below so that you fully understand what you are consenting to and what you wish to abstain from consenting to. You can also be sure that in the event that you provide consent and then wish to withdraw that consent, I will ensure that your wishes and the wishes of the child are fully respected, and data is erased as quickly as it was provided. (Please note this applies only to data which isn't required by law and has a time frame placed upon it – this include any accident forms which have been collected). The types of data that I will immediately withdraw from your instruction are:

- Photographs
- Examples of children's work and creativity
- Observations (with the exception of the two-year check which is a legal requirement and data will be shared with the child's health visitor)

Any photographs that you have previously provided consent for in order to be shown on social media may not be able to be deleted completely. So please think carefully before agreeing for me to use photographs on a social media platform. Where agreed, we will also ways protect the facial identity of a child by placing a 'smiley' face over their face. This will ensure anonymity.
